THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE:

• Take the first dose during the evening before the colonoscopy (e.g., 5:00 to 9:00 PM) followed by five 8-ounce drinks of clear liquids before bed. Consume the clear liquids within 5 hours.

THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE

- Take the second dose <u>5 hours</u> before the colonoscopy followed by at least 3 8ounce drinks of clear liquids before the colonoscopy. <u>You must finish drinking</u> <u>all liquids by 4 hours before the procedure.</u>
- Take all of your usual morning medications <u>at least 4 hours prior to your</u> procedure unless otherwise directed by your physician
- ONCE YOU ARE WITHIN 4 HOURS OF YOUR SCHEDULED EXAM TIME YOU MUST HAVE NOTHING TO EAT, DRINK, SMOKE OR CHEW.

PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU FIND IT NECESSARY TO CANCEL YOUR PROCEDURE WITHIN 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT A \$150 CANCELLATION FEE WILL BE CHARGED
